- Process of reallocating the rest of CBC programme funding (2021-27) to Interreg Aurora and Interreg Central Baltic Programmes






Flight passenges, total 1-8/2023

Investments in North Finland, North Sweden and North Norway until 2030: 160 miljard euros! *




Forest and bioeconomy

- Forest coverage is 77% of the Eastern and Northern Finland's area.
- The annual growth is 65.5 million cubic metres and the annual felling is 44 million cubic metres.
- The number of private forest owners by place of residence in the eight ENF regions is 213 780.
- The forest sector employs around 60 000 people throughout Finland, paying an average of €2.2 billion in wages and salaries each year.
- In 2020, renewable energy consumption in Finland was 44.6%, of which 71% came from biofuels. They account for 28% of Finland's total energy consumption and were thus the most used energy source.
- East and North Finland has strong forest expertise (Luke + higher education institutions).
