

Recommendations:

- Renewable energy projects have become commercially viable over time
- Photovolatic projects have a relatively short payback time
- Individual photovoltaic rooftop projects have a higher cost than large scale projects

- Contact our thematic experts
- Define with them the main policy challenge you want to address
- Submit a short online application

PREPARE and select peers:

- Draft a thematic background paper about your challenge
- Select your peers from the list prepared by our experts
- Join an online meeting to finalise your peer review agenda
- Book the meeting venue
- Invite your relevant local stakeholders





HOST your peer review:

- 2-day meeting in your region
- Our experts moderate and facilitate
- You present your policy challenge (optional - interviews with your key stakeholders)
- Our experts and the peers propose policy recommendations and "to-do-list" for your region
- Recommendations are presented to you and your key decision-makers for feedback





FOLLOW-UP:

- Draft a **short report** with the solutions identified and the follow-up actions
- Reply to our evaluation survey
- Discuss in a **follow up interview** with our experts about the results (a few months later)



Peer review KEY FEATURES



Costs covered by the platform:

- For hosts:
 - Catering, interpretation and local transport (if needed)
- For peers:
 - Travel and accommodation costs
 - Flat Daily Allowance (FDA) of EUR 350 for up to three working days (upon request per organisation)
